The Central Coast Council, pursuant to Section 87 and Section 88 of the *Food Act 2003* hereby registers the business

as a food business for the handling of food for sale or the sale of food subject to the following condition(s):

- Compliance with the *Food Act 2003* and the *Australia New Zealand Food Standards Code*.
- A digital probe thermometer that can accurately measure the temperature of potentially hazardous food to $\pm 1^{\circ}\text{C}$ and has a minimum temperature range of -50°C to 150°C must be readily accessible to food handlers at all times.
- The business must not manufacture or serve undercooked or raw egg products unless in accordance with the Department of Health and Human Services *Manufacturing Controls for Raw Egg Products 2008*, and must seek the written approval of the Council's Environmental Health Officer.

This Certificate of Registration will remain in force for a period of 12 months expiring on **31 January 2018**.

Review:

In accordance with section 93, you may apply to the Magistrates Court (Administrative Appeals Division) for a review of decisions relating to registration within 28 days after:

- (a) Issue of the certificate of registration under section 87(6) or renewal of registration under section 89(4); or
- (b) giving of notice of refusal under section 87(7) or section 89(5); or
- (c) service of the notice of the variation, suspension or cancellation under section 91(5).
