

To whomever it may concern,

At Camp Clayton the safety of children is something that we take seriously. We want all young people to know that they are safe on our site, and to ensure that you as organisations hiring Camp Clayton are comfortable in the safety that we provide.

In Tasmania we have the Registration to Work with Vulnerable People Act of 2013, with amendments made in 2016. This act is one designed to help protect children and other vulnerable people.

According to the requirements specified by this act we, as Camp Clayton, require all staff and volunteers to have a current Working with Vulnerable People check.

We also have implemented the use of Child Safe's – Safety Management Online system to keep track of our staff member's checks and their expiries.

In light of this, we, as Camp Clayton declare that;

We have processes in place to ensure that our paid and volunteer staff are adhering to the Registration to Work with Vulnerable People Act 2013.

That our paid and volunteer staff are required to have a current Working with Vulnerable People Check

That we ensure our staff are registered with our organisation so that we are updated with any changes to their registration.
