At Camp Clayton the safety of children and vulnerable people is something we take seriously. We are committed to providing a child-safe and child-friendly environment.

In Tasmania we have the Registration to Work with Vulnerable People Act of 2013, with amendments made in 2016. This act is one designed to help protect children and other vulnerable people.

According to the requirements specified by this act, and the recommendation from the Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Sexual Abuse we, as Camp Clayton, require all staff and volunteers to have a current Working With Vulnerable People check.

We also have implement the use of ChildSafe SP3 System, and is committed to sound implementation of it.

In light of this we, as Camp Clayton declare that:

We have processes in place to ensure that our paid and volunteer staff are adhering to the Registration to Work with Vulnerable People Act 2013.

That our paid and volunteer staff are required to have a current Working with Vulnerable People Check.

That we ensure our staff are registered with our organisation so that we are updated with any changes to their registration.

As the safety of children and vulnerable people is paramount to Camp Clayton, it will adhere to its working with vulnerable people policy.
